
<u>WELCOME TO</u> <u>DEEP CANYON GUEST RANCH</u> <u>Where the West begins</u>

Our gentle mountain trained horses are suited for all levels of riding experience.





The beginner can learn to handle a horse under the watchful eyes of our wranglers and be off for a trail ride the first day. We will venture into the mountains along Clary Coulee, through the foothills toward Blackleaf Canyon, or Flattop Mountain, with stunning panoramic views. When not riding, you can hike in the area. Bring your camera, binoculars, wild flower and bird book. Any time is an excellent time to visit *Deep Canyon Guest Ranch*. Wild flowers keep the area under a patchwork of color.



If you enjoy fishing, try your hand at catching native cutthroat trout in the pristine waters of the Teton which is but a short walk from the ranch. There are many excellent fishing holes waiting for you to wet your line along the length of the river. A fishing license is required and may be purchased in Choteau or online.



Hopefully catch a glimpse of the mule deer, elk, antelope, mountain goat, bear and numerous other animals that call this land their home. Engulf yourself in the natural wild splendours of the area.
